





Recommendation	The Commissioner is recommended to approve an agreement for Public-i to provide webcasting services for 36 months (from 30 June 2017).
Is the decision of significant public interest	Yes
Summary of reasons for decision	<p>The OSPCC's Communications & Engagement Department has issued a 'request for quotation' under the terms of the National Framework Agreement for Webcasting Services (ref. PROC16-0133) let by Braintree District Council. Two suppliers (one of which is the incumbent supplier; Public-i) are listed under this framework.</p> <p>Only one supplier (the incumbent supplier; Public-i) provided a quotation within the timescales provided. The reason(s) why the second supplier chose not to bid have been sought for future learning.</p> <p>The quotation from Public-i was independently, then subsequently jointly, reviewed by OSPCC officers. Having applied a scoring methodology provided by Sussex Police the quotation was deemed to "meet the Client's requirements and standards in the areas being measured well, so that the Services will be delivered well and in a way that is responsive to the needs of the Customers, the Client and other stakeholders."</p>
