| Is the decision of significant public interest | Yes -This initiative has the potential to reduce / prevent business crime and build confidence in the police. It will be part of the "Immediate Justice" programme funded by the Home office and DHLUC. |
| Summary of reasons for decision | <p>As part of the recently launched ASB Action Plan, the Government is working with 10 initial trailblazer police force areas. The Sussex PCC has been allocated funding to design and deliver reparation for offenders to swiftly repair damage in a range of ways with the ambition of them starting this within 48 hours from a Police decision.</p> <p>The grant provides funding for reparative services and activity The OSPCC is seeking applications from providers who have the capability and capacity to identify and deliver reparation in the community.</p> |
| Consultation undertaken | Reviewed by the Immediate Justice Grant Assessment panel on the 31 st of July 2023. It scored 63.75 out of a possible 100. The Panel recommends that this project be funded. |
