Recommendation	To provide a £25,000 grant to provide 50% of the total costs for the enhanced KICKs programme in Sussex targeting areas of serious violence. Project period 1 <sup>st</sup> September 2023 to 31 <sup>st</sup> August 2024.

Summary of reasons for decision	AiTC in partnership with the Premier League Charitable Trust provide an enhanced KICKs programme across Sussex. The purpose of the grant is to increase the capability and capacity of the KICKs programme to those areas suffering from serious violence. The programme through the power of sport, engages young people at risk of becoming involved in risky behaviours and promotes good life choices.
Consultation undertaken	The governance of the KICKs programme is through Sussex Violence Reduction Partnership. This decision notice is supported by a detailed report recommending the programme expansion after extensive consultation with partners through a enhanced KICKs working group.
